Workflow Progress - Graphic

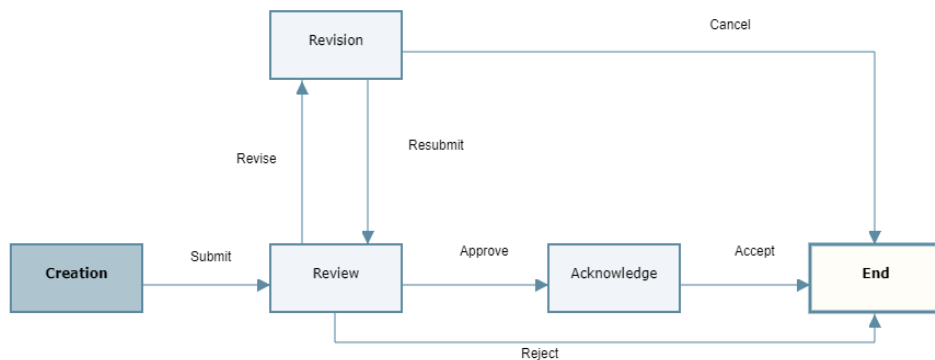


Figure 1. Flexible workflow design to mirror an agency’s approval process.

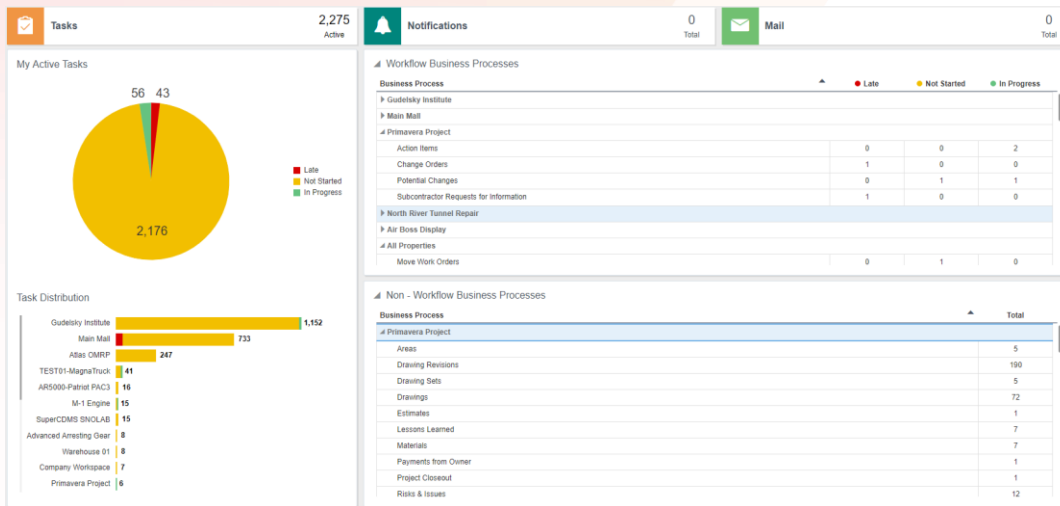


Figure 2. Dashboards provide visibility into all activity across the agency.
